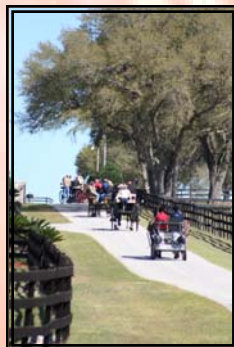
The Southern Ride & Drive & CAA Proficiency Testing March 4-7, 2010
